At its April meeting last Sunday, the Council reviewed financial reports, approved the previous meetings' minutes and heard a report from the Senior Pastor on the church's active ministry.

The Abiding

Presence ELCA Fund for Leaders seminary scholarship for 2024-2025 was designated to Seminarian David Lewis, a member of Abiding Presence.

Planning continued to help the congregation recognize three significant staff anniversaries this calendar year. Sharon Downs, Financial Secretary & Food Ministry Coordinator, and Melody Light, Office Assistant, will both celebrate 15-years on the staff team on July 1. A reception will be held in their honor on Sunday, May 19. Please contact Heather Pace in the church office if you can help with the reception (see page 4).

David Chávez, Music & Worship Minister, will celebrate 10-years on the staff team on September 15. In recognition of Dave's anniversary, the Council has offered him a paid commission to write a piece of music. This piece of music will debut on September 15 alongside a celebration of Dave's ministry.

The parsonage lease was discussed. The current lease terminates on June 15. Conversations are underway with the Afghan family we resettled into the parsonage last year to determine if a lease extension is possible.

Financial Update

In the spirit of transparency and good fiscal management, I want to share with you that at its April council meeting the Church Council voted to ease the restriction on dedicated account 3730 – Youth Gathering. This change was discussed with the Finance Committee prior to the Council's action.

This donor restricted dedicated account was set up many years ago (before my time as your pastor) as a savings account for the ELCA triennial Youth Gathering. The youth would save over the course of three years to offset the significant cost of attending the gathering.

Due to the pandemic, the ELCA Youth Gathering was postponed and then cancelled in 2021. There is an ELCA Youth Gathering scheduled for this July. Pastor Kelsey and I explored sending a group to the event this summer. The significant cost (over \$1,500/person for a 5-day event) and the impact to our vibrant congregational summer youth program made the ELCA Youth Gathering a less than attractive opportunity for our congregation, especially the youth we talked with about it. We decided to not send a group to this 5-day event and focus instead on the ministry we do all summer long here through our Abiding Fellows and College-Age Interns.

Currently there is a balance of \$3,226.40 sitting in dedicated account 3730 – Youth Gathering. No new money has been deposited into the account since the end of 2020. These funds are the result of fundraising efforts within the congregation prior to 2020 and seed money left from previous ELCA Youth Gathering years.

Rather than leaving the money sitting unused for at least another three years, the Church Council voted to put the money to use for this summer's Abiding Fellows program. We feel that using the money toward the summer Abiding Fellows program is in keeping with the spirit of the account's prior donations - summer youth faith formation.
